 - academic and behavioral outcomes for school-aged children in families who experienced homelessness

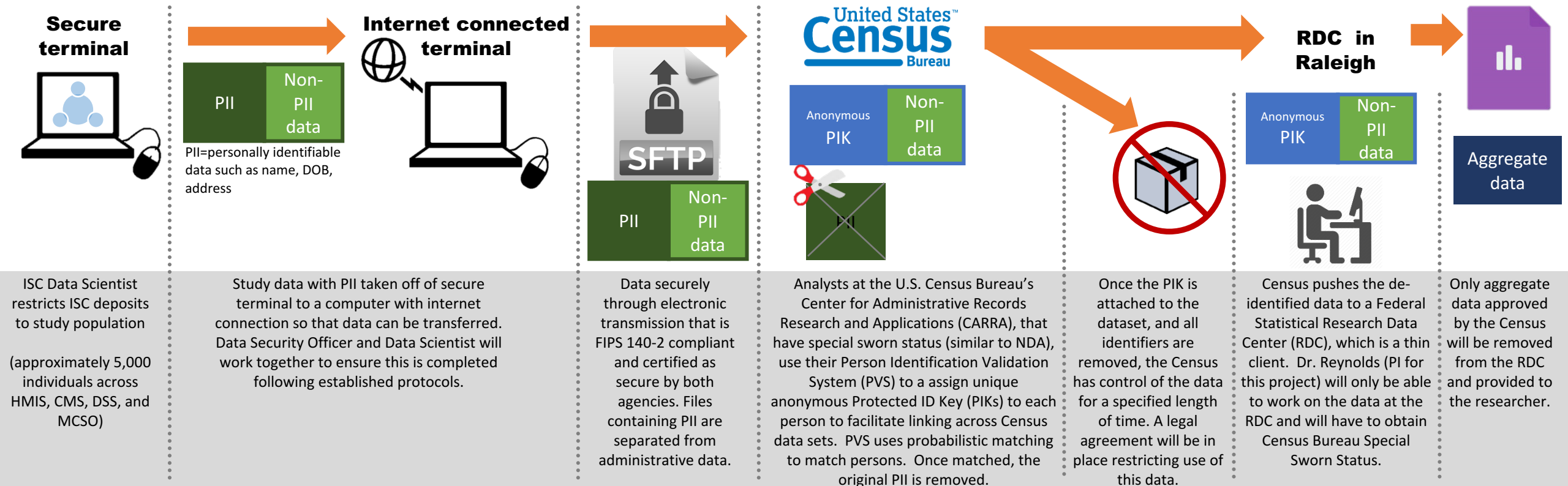
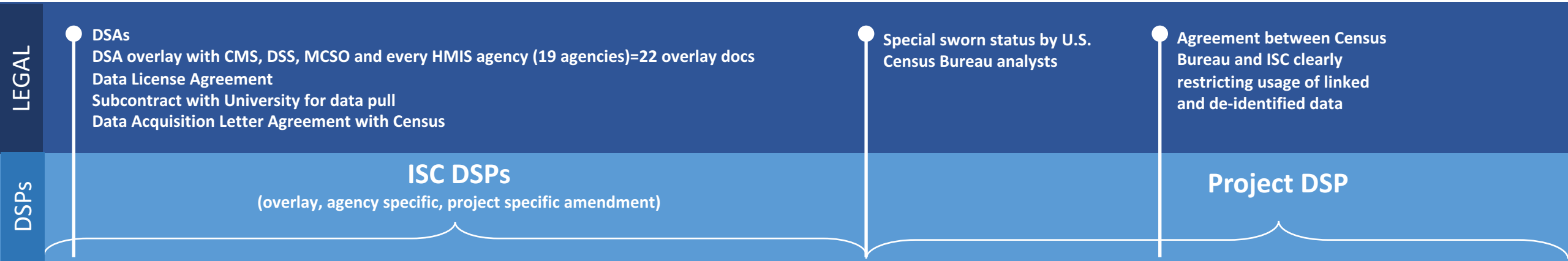
